Food & Drink

Alamosa Public Library strives to provide a welcoming, comfortable environment where our customers can imagine, learn, and grow. We understand that while visiting the library customers may want to enjoy a drink or snack. By promoting responsible user behavior, this policy attempts to achieve a balance between our users' social needs and the need to preserve and protect our collections.

We ask that library users follow the guidelines listed below to ensure a clean, safe, and welcoming environment for all:

- Limit snacks to dry foods such as nuts, pretzels, cookies, or candy. Pizza, hamburgers, fries, sandwiches, salads, etc. are not considered snack foods.
- Non-alcoholic drinks in covered containers (spill proof cups, bottles with screw caps, travel mugs, sports bottles, soda cans, cups with a top, juice boxes, etc.).
- Be considerate of others and clean up after yourself. Dispose of any food and drink-related trash before you leave.
- Please use caution near computers and other electronic equipment.
- Refrain from drinking or eating in areas that are posted "NO FOOD OR DRINK".

We know that accidents happen, so if you accidentally spill something please clean it up and let a staff member know so that we can ensure that damaged materials are properly treated.

This policy is designed to balance the needs of the library with the convenience of our customers. We encourage library customers to help us monitor this policy.
