Filtering

Since the Internet access computers are located in public areas which must be shared by library users of all ages, background and sensibilities, the library staff reserves the right to ask individuals to discontinue the display of information and images which violate the use agreement.

Per the Library Filtering Bill (HB 04-1004) Technology protection measure is operating on all public computers that are available to children to protect children from access to harmful material.

All computers in the children's area are being controlled by a content server and shall never be disabled. All computer's that are near or facing the children's area (#9- 15) are being controlled by a content server and shall never disabled.

Minors shall never be allowed access to any blocked internet sites. Minors shall never request content server be disabled. "Minor" means any person who has not attained the age of seventeen years.

Adults may request the content server be disabled. Proof of age may be requested by a librarian before disabling the filtering program. Librarians may review the content being viewed by a patron at any time, and terminate a session if determines the content is inappropriate.

Additional sites may be blocked as seen fit by the Lead-Librarian, Director, or City Computer IT.
