Minutes of Meeting March 20, 2018

- 1. Call to Order:** Meeting started at 5:30 p.m. Present were Dawn Krebs, Patty Campbell, Salai Taylor, and Don Thompson. Note: no quorum.
- 2. Reading of Minutes:** Minutes from last month were read, but no motion for lack of quorum. Minutes for February and December will be carried over and voted on at the next meeting.
- 3. Finance:** Don reported there is just over \$6,000 in sales. Approval of report carried over to next month.
- 4. Book bike events:**
 - Signs: Are here and look good. Discussed best way to attach them to bike.
 - Weekends on the Rio: Salai discussed riding the book bike during this event, and other summer events. Possibly have it out on Sundays for the Sundays at Six event, as well as the Farmer's Market and Summerfest.

- 10. Reading at Evergreen:** Currently being done by three people - could use a fourth.
